

SIMS Data Import Cheatsheets

SIMS data elements

- Almost all SIMS data elements begin with “SIMS”, and are easily searched through the API
- <https://www.datim.org/api/dataElements?filter=name:like:SIMS>
- There are some exceptions, so consult the datasets for exact details of which data elements are present in each dataset

Option sets

- Many SIMS data elements use the “SIMS value” option set.
- An option set is just a list of possible values

Option sets

- When importing data into DATIM, you should use the “code” of the particular option (e.g. 1) not the name “Red”
- Consult specific option codes for details

Period format

- SIMS data is recorded on a monthly basis.
- The format of the “period” should be YYYYmm,
- YYYY stands for the year (e.g 2015)
- mm stands for the month (e.g. 02 for February)
- Be sure to include the zero for months prior to August

Organisation units / Sites

- SIMS Above site can only be entered at the OU level
- SIMS community can only be entered at the community level
- SIMS Facility can only be entered at facility level
- In version 2.21, invalid organisation units will be rejected

Data value types

- **Long text:** Restricted to 50,000 characters
- **True only:** Only accepts “true”
- **Boolean:** Only accepts “true” or “false”
- **Option sets:** Only accept valid option codes, typically numeric
- **Dates:** Only accepts valid dates (e.g 2015-05-10) or timestamps without time zones (e.g 2015-05-10 12:13:56)

Data value set templates

- DHIS2 can help you generate a template for import into DATIM
- Just substitute the UID of the dataset you need a template for
