The ICT governance

Rwanda has made significant investments in building a **robust telecommunications network** and **increasing Internet Connectivity, laying the foundations for widespread digital access.**

The Role of the Ministry of ICT

Policy Formulation	➤	MINICT is responsible for developing and implementing policies related to information communication technology. This includes strategies to enhance ICT infrastructure, promote digital literacy, and foster innovation in the ICT sector.
Regulation and Compliance	➤	The ministry is involved in creating and enforcing regulations related to ICT activities, ensuring compliance with national standards and legal frameworks.
Infrastructure Development	➤	MINICT is involved in initiatives to develop and upgrade ICT infrastructure, including broadband networks, to enhance connectivity across the country.
Digital inclusion	➤	The ministry may work towards promoting digital inclusion by ensuring access to ICT resources and technologies for all segments of the population
Innovation and Startups	➤	MINICT may support and encourage innovation in the ICT sector, including the development of startups and entrepreneurship in technology-related fields.
Cybersecurity	➤	Ensuring the security of information and communication systems is likely a significant aspect of MINICT's responsibilities, including measures to protect against cyber threats.
Implementation of National Strategies	➤	The ministry may play a key role in implementing national development strategies, such as the National Strategy for Transformation (NST), with a focus on integrating ICT into broader development goals.

The Role of RISA(the Agency of MINICT)

- **RISA** oversees the implementation of Smart Rwanda Master Plan initiatives
- **RISA** has the mission of digitalizing the Rwandan society through increased usage of ICT and innovation technology as a cross-cutting enabler for the development of other sectors.
- **RISA** leads Rwanda's digital and social economic transformation.
- **RISA** Coordinates the implementation of projects that deliver information and communication technology services,
- RISA is also in charge of digitalizing government services and ensures that they are easily accessed by the citizens.

Chief Digital Officer position

The CDO Structure's vision within the Government of Rwanda aims to utilize digital transformation initiatives for *enhancing service delivery*, *boosting efficiency*, and *fostering economic growth across* all sectors.

The concept of “**shared services**”

The core idea involves aligning institutions with *similar mandates into sectors*, where a "sector" denotes a leading Ministry with its affiliated agencies operating in the same line of business.

This Strategy revolves around *shared IT services* and *personnel* to cater to the *collective needs and plans of the entire Sector*. Ministries with shared IT units are overseen by either a Chief Digital Officer or an IT Business Analyst.

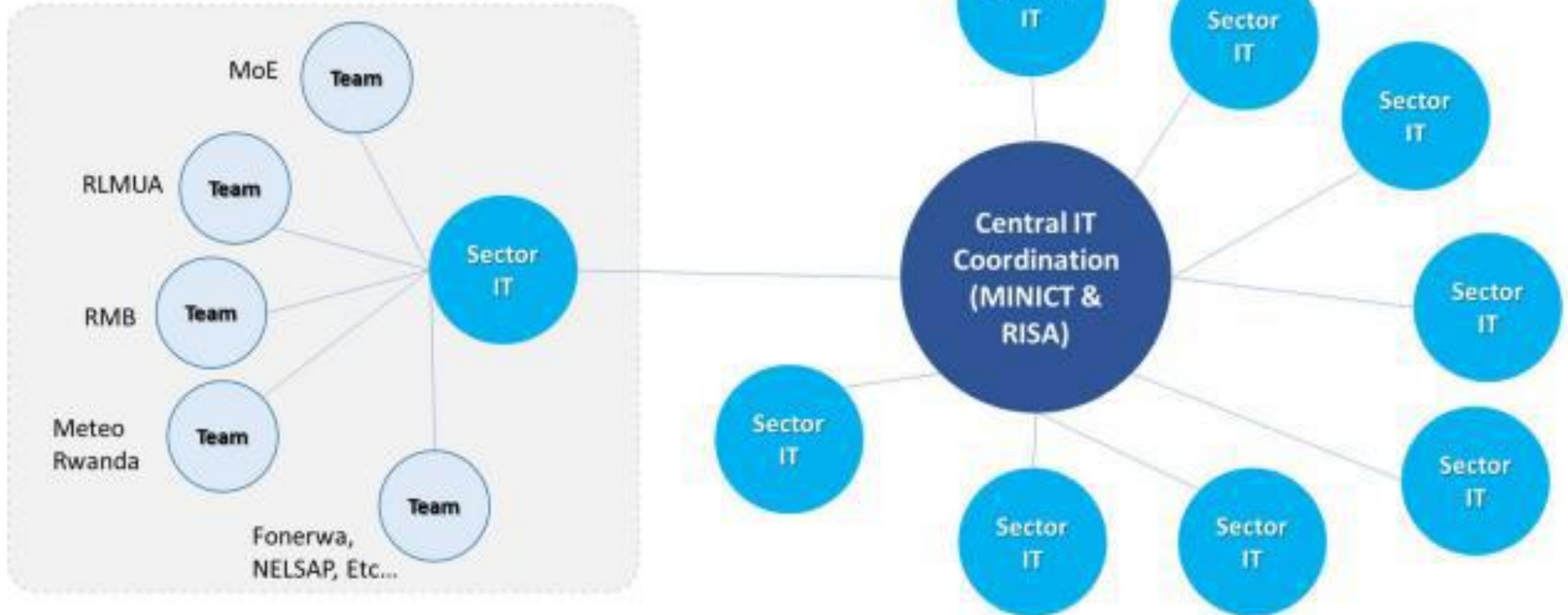

Example of a sector IT: case of the Environment and Disaster Management Sector

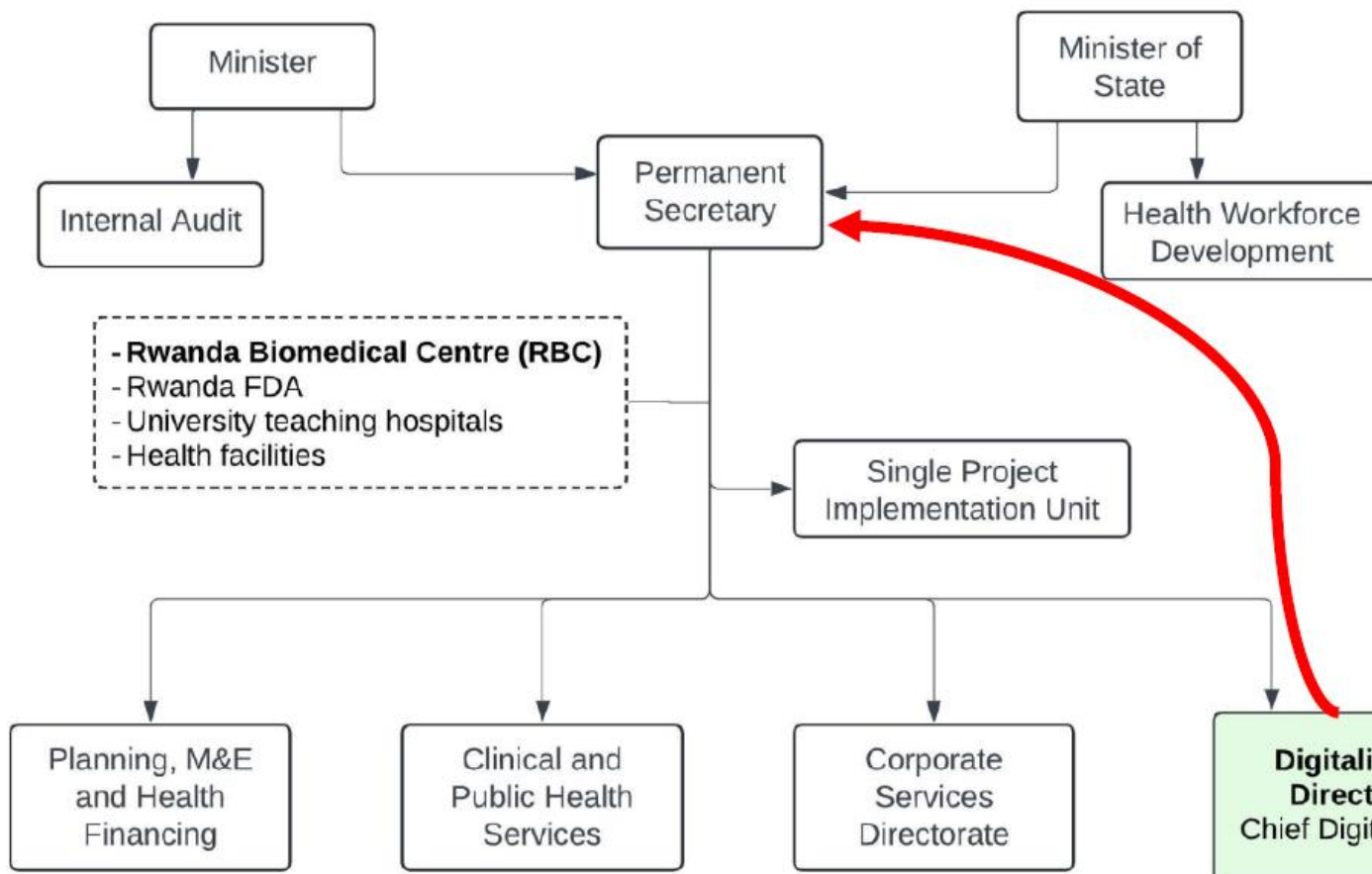

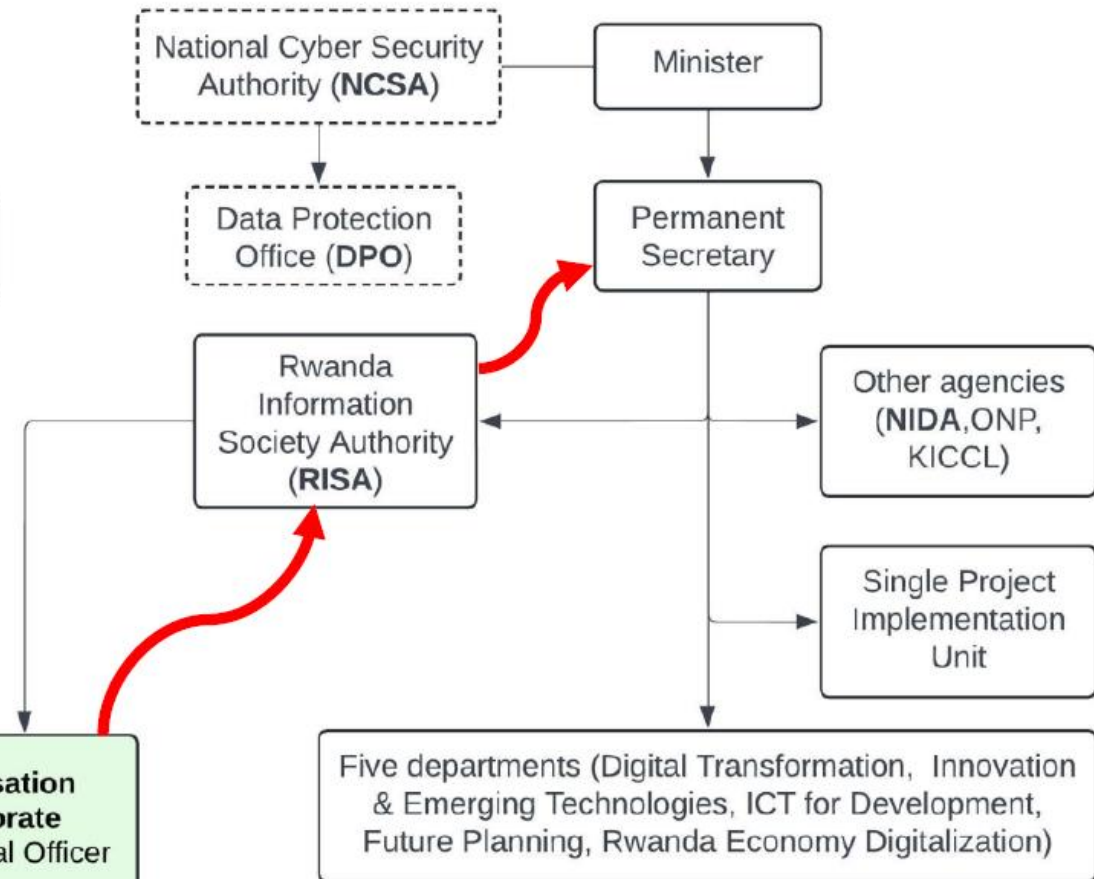


Digital Health Governance Structure
